Jackson Gillies and JAX PLAYS DEAD 'Return to the Alcazar'

Film and music event is set for Friday, Oct. 24, at 7 p.m.

After intermission, the second set will launch, featuring *JAX PLAYS DEAD*, a Jackson Gillies project celebrating the music of the Grateful Dead.

Jackson's new *JAX PLAYS DEAD* merchandise will debut that evening, created by internationally known chalk artist **Rod Tryon**, who's been featured at Santa Barbara's I Madonnari Festival for decades. To celebrate the return of *JAX PLAYS DEAD* to the Alcazar, Rod will create a *JAX PLAYS DEAD* drawing right out front on the theatre's sidewalk beginning around noon. The drawing should take about five hours to complete, so please stop by Friday, Oct. 24, and say hi to Rod.

The Grateful Dead has a longstanding tradition of collaborating with artists to create concert posters and such. Available at the show will also be *JAX PLAYS DEAD* merchandise created by **Kenny Schneidman** and **Karen Payton**, all facilitated by **Val Selvaggio** (aka Little Val).
